We are kicking off an exciting 2025 with Social Sprint. Our goal: to develop small digital prototypes that directly support youth clubs, schools, and civil society initiatives. With tools like QuickPermit, ClubEventManager, and DemoForm, we have laid the foundation – now we want to grow.

First Steps

In recent months, we successfully tested QuickPermit in a youth club.

The result: significantly more young people could participate spontaneously in events – less bureaucracy, more opportunities.

This demonstrates the potential of our idea.

Strategy for the Coming Months

Over the next three months, we aim to reach at least 50 youth clubs.

To achieve this, we will focus on pilot projects, partnerships with associations, social media reach, and local press coverage.

Milestones 2025

- Redesign of the four websites (Social Sprint, QuickPermit, ClubEventManager, DemoForm)
- Building a core team (Design, Marketing, Tech, Organization)
- First showcase events with Berlin youth clubs
- Launch of OpenCollective for transparent funding

Long-Term Potential

Europe and North America have around 35,800 youth clubs.

If we reach 5%, 1,800 clubs will use our tools.

This means more participation for young people, greater visibility for youth clubs, and a strong foundation for future social projects.
